Given the sea of Galilee's topography, such a storm could descend onto the sea quickly without notice and, at night, could hardly be anticipated. The sea is some seven hundred feet below sea level and is depressed with hills surrounding it. The hills on the east side are particularly steep (Hendrickson 1978: 439-440). Cool air rushing down the ravines and hills around the lake can collide with warm air above the lake and create an instant storm in the confined quarters (Fitzmyer 1981: 729)." ~Bock, D. Recognizing our Brokenness: Confession of Sin Public Prayer

Father, we confess that we have not trusted your promise of safe passage through our storms. Instead we find ourselves frantically paddling or despairing. Additionally, we have not remembered that your presence ensures our safety. We have demanded evidence of your power that we might trust you. But we have not lived the life of faith that you have called us to.

Lord, you have filled the scriptures with evidence that this world answers to you alone. Help us to believe that in every one of our situations. In Jesus, we have seen that you are the keeper of promises. Your Spirit is continual evidence of your presence. Enable us to always live this truth, because Jesus entered the ultimate storm of God's judgement for us so that we might always be delivered from our storms and brought safely into your presence.
